We are happy to share the glad news that our students of XII & X who appeared for the 2021-22 in board examination passed with flying colours. We achieved 100% results in both classes. In class XII, 85% students passed with first division and 15% with second division and in class X, 92% students passed in first division and 8% in second division. In class X **Prashant Singh S/o Shailendra Bahadur Singh** topped the school with 97%. In class XII **Ayushi Pandey D/o Sachidanand Pandey of PCB** stream was the highest scorer with 95.6%. All the toppers of the school were awarded in a prize distribution ceremony.
