Smt. Chandra Welfare Society is an Educational Charitable Society registered in the year 1999. It has been managing Chandra Public School since 2003. It is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, since 2010.

Academics

Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of the endeavor of all educators and academic institutions. An effective assessment of this pursuit is how the institution has performed in the examinations conducted by the CBSE.

It was a gratifying experience to see the brilliant performance of the students of CPS continuously in the examinations of the CBSE since the 1st batch. In the AISSE 2024 exam, CPS set a state record by securing the first and second positions in Mau District. While both Kshitij Raghuvanshi and Shilpi Yadavof our school became the district toppers with 97.6% each, Shivbrat Yadav and Shashwat Gupta of our school secured the second position with 97.4% each. 62 students of our school obtained above 90% which was a record of Uttar Pradesh in CBSE result.

Similarly, in class XII,we witnessed stupendous performance from the part of our students, with SanskarAgrawal scoring 95.4% in Commerce, and Disha Rai securing 94.4% in Commerce. Out of the total 169 students who appeared in 2024, 121 students secured first division and 48 students secured second division.

Over these years, Chandra Public School has created many high achievers, and I have no doubt whatsoever that they will go on to distinguish themselves in the years to come and will continue to make us feel proud.

We are proud of our legacy as a disciplined educational institution. In a survey conducted by the Gloria Educational Society, Bangalore, Chandra Public School was placed at 11thrank in the parameter of Academic Excellence out of the best 250 schools in the country affiliated to the CBSE and ICSE.

Staff

Staff Enrichment Programmes

Our teachers constantly strive to stay updated in association with Centre of Excellence, CBSE, Prayagaraj, by attending workshops and various training programmes. Various workshops for language teachers and subject-wise teachers were held, introducing innovative methods of classroom teaching.

Student Enrichment Programmes

To ensure that our students are equipped to face any challenges, we have focused on student enrichment programmes. In addition, Parent-TeacherMeetings are held at regular intervals to review the activities of the students and seek parents' participation and feedback.

School Parliament Election and Election of Club Heads

The school witnessed elections for the school parliament and house group captains with a touch of authentic election process. Vibhu Goswamiof Class 12th Biology was elected as the School Captain and Pariniti Raiof Class XI Biology as the School Vice-Captain.

In order to strengthen the talents of the students in different spheres, the school has its various clubs. Elections were held to select students to head these clubs for the academic year.

Co-Curricular Activities

By providing a conducive and encouraging environment, the students are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and interschool activities and competitions.

A workshop on 'Cyber Security' was held on 12th July 2024 to make students aware of this vital subject, in which Mr. Jason Joseph, Chief Information Officer, Cyber Wing, Bengaluru, and Mr. Shailendra Kumar Kannaujya, Inspector, Cyber Security, spoke to the students on important aspects like cyber threats, ethical hacking, and saving privacy on the Internet.

On 23rd August 2024, a drawing and painting competition was organized for the students, in which Tanya Jaiswal of Class XII (Red House) won the first prize while the second prize was secured by MansiJaiswal of class XI (Blue House). The third prize was shared by Raman Singh of class XI (Green House) and AnshDevraj of class IX (Red House). The drawing competition not only provided a space for artistic expression but also fostered a sense of community and collaboration in the students.

For the purpose of creating a sense of social responsibility in children and to emphasize the importance of cleanliness, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was organized by the Eco Club on 2nd October 2024 on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti.

The school hosted the 1st Inter-District Open Karate Championship on 27th August 2024, and many students from CPS won gold, silver, and bronze medals.

The students of our school participated in the 19th State Karate Championship held at BHU Varanasi, and exhibited exemplary performance and got awarded.
